

RESOLUTION 26-002

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SANIBEL FIRE AND RESCUE DISTRICT APPROVING ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF OVERTIME FOR RELOCATION PURPOSES; SUPERSEDING CONFLICTING POLICIES; PROVIDING FOR ACCOUNTABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Sanibel Fire and Rescue District ("District") is preparing to move out of Fire Station 171 and into temporary office facilities; and

WHEREAS, facilitating this move safely and efficiently requires significant administrative effort and coordination outside of normal operating hours over the next sixty (60) days; and

WHEREAS, current District policy restricts the authorization and accumulation of overtime for administrative staff strictly to declared states of emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it necessary and in the best interest of the District to temporarily supersede this policy to ensure a smooth transition during the relocation process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SANIBEL FIRE AND RESCUE DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1 – The Board hereby approves and authorizes overtime for administrative staff for the next sixty (60) days to facilitate the relocation out of Station 171 and into temporary offices.

Section 2 – This resolution shall expressly supersede the District's existing policy of only obtaining overtime during a state of emergency for the specified sixty (60) day period.

Section 3 – The Fire Chief shall be strictly responsible for the accountability and oversight of all recorded hours during this time period to ensure organizational efficiency and fiscal responsibility.

Section 4 – This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

Commissioner Cochran, who moved for its adoption, offered the foregoing resolution. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Muench, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
